### **Y1 Phonics Screening**

Every year, children in year 1 sit the national phonics screening check. This year the screening check will take place in the **week beginning 12th June**. Parents and carers of children in year 1 are invited to a meeting on **Monday 15th May at 4:30pm** to find out more about this check.

### Y2 SATs

Our year 2's begin their end of key stage assessments this week, otherwise known as SATs. They have worked hard all year in preparing for these, and we would like to wish them the best of luck!

### **Trips**

Trip letters have been sent home today. We know that many of you were keen for your children to be able to experience school trips again since the hiatus caused by the pandemic. With the rising cost of living and fuel the cost of coaches and entrance to venues has increased. In order to help keep costs to a minimum, the HIP group has contributed towards the cost of all the trips, meaning that we have been able to reduce the costs for everyone. ### Coronation Picnic Reminders

### Thursday 4th May 3.15pm - 5pm

We are looking forward to celebrating the coronation of King Charles next Thursday after school. Please collect your children from their class as usual at 2.55pm and set up your picnic blanket on the school field. Please remember not to bring alcohol or nuts as part of your picnic.

The stalls and games will be open from around 3.15pm. There will be an ice-cream van, cake stall and raffle, temporary tattoos and nail painting, hook a duck, guess the name of the bear, royal races and a royal photo-booth, along with other games and music. Don't forget to bring small change to use at the stalls. Please remember, children will need an adult's permission to have a temporary tattoo or their nails painted.

HIP group has very kindly paid for either an ice-cream or lolly for every pupil in school and nursery from the ice-cream van! Children will be given a ticket on Thursday to exchange for their chosen treat. However, do remember to bring along some small change for ice-creams for other family members. The ice-cream van will be staying until 5pm, so don't worry about missing out!

Children attending Superkids will also be able to join in, with the Superkids staff, who will pack up a special picnic for them for their tea! These children can bring in some money from home (no more than £5) in a named wallet, which staff can help them spend at the picnic. Those attending Superkids will return to the nursery building from 4:30pm for collection as normal. Should you be planning to pick up before then, please call the Superkids mobile phone (07925197540) and a member of staff will meet you on the ramp outside the Y1 classrooms with your child.

Siblings from Halfway Junior School are also welcome to attend and families will be able to re-enter the school site once they have collected from the Junior School.

As ever with outdoor events, we will keep checking on the weather and should it be very wet we will let all our families know by lunchtime on Thursday should the event need to be postponed.

Staff and volunteers will be on hand to join in with the celebrations and help all our families have a wonderful picnic. However, please ensure you supervise your children at all times, particularly on any play equipment. Once children are collected they are their adult's responsibility. Staff cannot not be responsible for the supervision of children at the event.
